Think About It – Ron Koretz, P.M. Think About It

On May 21, 2021, Aiden Leos, a 6-year-old boy, was being driven to his school in

Orange County by his mother, Joanna Cloonan. About 8 AM, the two of them were cut off on
the freeway by a Volkswagen Golf Sportwagen, whose driver gave them the peace sign,
which Cloonan interpreted as being less than respectful. A few miles later, Cloonan passed
the Volkswagen and flashed her middle finger at the woman driving the Volkswagen, Wynne
Lee, and her male companion, Marcus Eriz. Ms. Lee then drove her Volkswagen to a position
behind the Cloonan vehicle and Eriz shot a bullet into it. Unfortunately, the bullet struck
Aiden, killing him. A few days later, and after an intensive search that included a \$500,000
reward, Eriz and Wynne were arrested. Wynne was charged with being an accessory afterthe-fact for failing to report the incident, a felony, and for carrying a concealed firearm in her
vehicle, a misdemeanor. Instead of cooperating with the law, she apparently took steps to
conceal the Volkswagen and tried to assist Eriz in avoiding arrest. Lee was place on home
confinement with GPS monitoring (ankle monitoring) in June 2021 pending her trial.

In January, 2024, Eriz was found guilty of second-degree murder and, in mid-April,

2024, he was sentenced to 40 years to life for that crime. Two weeks later, Lee pleaded guilty

for her part in the incident. The maximum sentence for her crime was 1460 days (4 years) in prison, which the Superior Court Judge, Richard King, imposed. However, Lee was given 2106 days of credit for her home confinement and good behavior, so she was viewed as having served all her time and was released. Thus, her real penalty was a fine for \$670 as well as some as yet undetermined amount of restitution.

If one does the math, no more than about 1065 days had passed between the time of her pre-trial confinement and her sentencing. During that time, I have no idea how many hours she was truly in her home, which was certainly more comfortable than a jail cell. Thus, it appears that her "good behavior" accounted for a significant reduction in her sentence. On the other hand, we do know exactly how much time Aiden spent confined to a structure much smaller than a jail cell, and his punishment will continue without end. The same can be said for the duration of the punishment for his mother, although she was not completely blameless for the shooting. Neither of them received any time off for good behavior.

The Orange County District Attorney, Todd Spitzer, was outraged by the sentence.

However, it is hard for me to believe that he did not see this coming. I do not know if he could have found some tougher felony to use in charging Lee, but perhaps the awarding of time off for good behavior needs some revising.
